A board-certified Family Nurse Practitioner, Dr. Ashley Dinkel is available to diagnose, treat, prescribe medications, provide education and refer patients to healthcare providers in the surrounding community. The following are available services the clinic provides. Please note this list is not comprehensive.

Wellness

- Annual physical exam
- Well-child/adolescent exam
- Sports physical (\$20 cash-pay, billed after visit)
- TB testing
- Pre-employment physical exam
- Weight management
- Immunizations (HPV, flu, meningitis, Tdap, etc.)
- Blood pressure screening
- Lab work (complete blood count, glucose, kidney/liver/thyroid function)
- STD testing (urine sample)
- Contraceptive counseling
- Pregnancy testing

Acute illness

- Rapid strep testing
- Rapid flu testing
- Urinary tract infection
- Sinus infection
- Pain and injury (such as headache, abdominal pain, sprained ankle or knee, elbow pain)

Chronic illness

- Diabetes
- High blood pressure
- High cholesterol
- Asthma
- Thyroid conditions
- Depression
- Anxiety
- Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD - requires referral for initial diagnosis)
- Substance use
